- The advantages and possible side effects of Implanon
- Contraindications/ warnings/ precautions
- Probable changes in bleeding pattern
- Possibility of longer bleeds
- The correct time to insert
- Insertion and removal techniques include minor surgical incision
- Probable small scar
- Implanon palpated in situ by HCP and patient
- Possible complications of insertion or removal (e.g. bruising, infection)
- Complications if Implanon is inserted incorrectly.
- When Implanon should be removed
- The option to discontinue Implanon at any time
- The rapid return of pre-existing fertility after removal of Implanon (commensurate with age)
- Current medications reviewed
- The provision of supportive information about Implanon
